

JAMBEROO TOUCH RULES

A player who performs a roll-ball without a touch being effected will be penalised. Jamberoo Touch has a **local rule** that if a defending player is in a position to make a touch and deliberately withdraws and the attacking player performs a roll-ball without a touch being effected, then the touch is deemed to be made and play on continues. This local rule was introduced to encourage a free flowing game, which is in the right spirit of our competition.

The only way that Jamberoo Touch can accommodate such a large number of teams in our competition, is through the continued use of players to referee a small proportion of the games held each night. When playing, can you please consider this fact and that this is a social competition.
